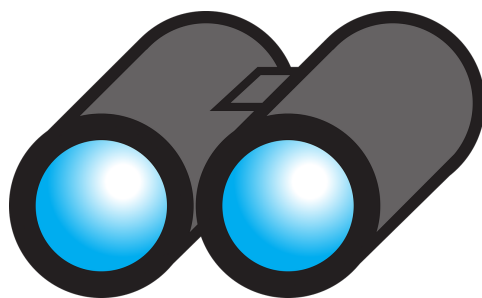


PRAYER IDEAS FOR FAMILIES

Watch the bubble go up in the sky.

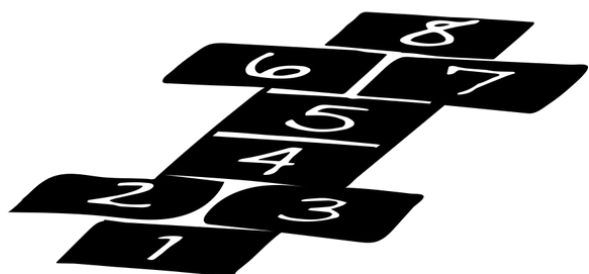


HOPSCOTCH PRAYERS

PRAYER STICKS

Find a handful of lollysticks and write down a friend or family member on each stick.

Each person has a piece of bubble wrap. Someone prays and says:

(unkind/selfish etc)

When the children say **'Amen'**
they pop the bubble
