Below is an overview of a selection of the many opportunities that are available. You may choose to do some of these, or have your own ideas.

- When you receive the weekly Emmanuel email take time to pray for the activities planned for the days and weeks ahead
- Keep a copy of the monthly guide somewhere visible, to remind you to pray for the activities listed
- o If you volunteer to help at an Emmanuel activity, commit to pray for this each week.
- Come and join the monthly Emmanuel prayer meeting Prayer At The Centre. This
 is always on the second Wednesday of the month from 8.00 9.00pm.
- Sign up to join the **Prayer Network**. This is a group of Emmanuel members that have committed to pray responsively for specific prayer requests from Emmanuel members and beyond
- There are several more specific prayer meetings for parents, Mission partners, persecuted Christians. You could join one of these.
- The **Saturday Morning prayer meeting**, from 9.00 9.40, prays for all the activities in the week ahead.
- Praying for the vision. Choose an aspect of the Emmanuel vision that you want to commit to pray for on a regular basis
- Prayer together as a homegroup for some aspects of the life of Emmanuel
- o When you start a church event or meeting you can begin with prayer.
